In the past year, Raven Rock has experienced an increase in not only children, but young adults who are struggling with mental health issues and finding the resources are too few to meet the demand.

There are some support systems in place for those who are under 18, but at age 18, people age-out of these systems. That is why we have changed our model to include these young adults who did not receive the help they needed before age 18 and now can't find a place to turn to for mental health services.

One such young lady, "Gwen" (not her real name) came to us with anxiety and depression that was so debilitating she could not keep a full-time job. She was out of high school, but did not have the money, motivation, or ability to go on to further her education. Her family had abandoned her, and she was alone in the world. When she came at 19, she had completely given up hope.

Raven Rock took her on as a client, on a full scholarship so that she could get the help she needed so desperately. Thanks to Tulalip Tribes charitable Fund, Gwen will receive **25 hours of free mental health care.**

Because of Tulalip Tribes charitable Fund, Gwen has restored hope. She has landed a ¾ time position that promises to give her more hours and potential to move up in the company. She hopes to get her own place next summer and her life is full of hope and optimism. Now her self-esteem is rising along with her hope. Gwen now knows she has potential and there is a reason to live.
