Dear Ms. Sheldon,

Thank you again for the Tulalip Tribe's support of Rebuilding Together Thurston County. Because of the Tribe's generous support and support from others in our community, we repaired and provided ADA modifications on 59 homes in 2022 and have already provided services on another 13 homes in 2023. We improved the lives of 105 residents; 73% of whom were disabled and 46% were 62 and older. Projects completed included wheelchair ramps, restoration of hot running water by installing new hot water tanks, new stairs, grab bars, and power restoration. We repaired Harold's furnace - it wouldn't shut off and his home was a "toasty" 82 degrees which caused great discomfort and a large power bill. We installed a new power line for Kathy between a PSE power pole and her electrical panel - she had been living without electricity for three weeks and had no hot running water, no stove, no refrigerator, no heat, etc. We installed a new hot water tank for Barbara, who called the office in tears because her hot water tank had failed and she had water spilling into her utility room.

We are very grateful for your support and the help we can provide our low income neighbors because of your financial assistance. We look forward to continuing to work with the Tulalip Tribe!
