Red Curtain Foundation for the Arts is grateful for the Tulalip Tribes' continued support of our organization's mission of providing arts education and programming for the residents of north Snohomish County. The most recent grant request (Q2 2018) helped us fund some fire and safety improvements at the arts center, mandated by the City of Marysville, and complete the build-out of the center's concession space, while helping to support RCF's theatre programming.

Attendance at Red Curtain's plays average 65 per performance (9 performances each for 7 shows in the season) -- just over 4,000 audience members. Our in-house classes for kids, teens, and adults serve about 40 students per session, with 5 sessions per year. In addition, Red Curtain's outreach efforts, running after-school drama clubs for two of Marysville School District's elementary schools, attracted an additional 60 students this year (with plans to expand for next school year).

We're preparing now for our two immersive youth theatre activities, with Springboard (for ages 9-15) beginning May 20 and Summer Stars (ages 15-19) starting June 23. We anticipate participation of about 50 students in the two 6-week programs, each culminating in fully- staged musical theatre productions that will showcase the young actors' skills.

Volunteer participation adds another 150+ people to those numbers, which brings the total number of people impacted by Red Curtain over the last year to at least 4,600.

I have attached photos of the sprinkler installation (additional service installed in the bathrooms, office, greenroom and under the stairs), and the newly-built concession stand, as well as a couple of photos from last year's Springboard production of "A Kidsummer Night's Dream." We would be happy to share other photos or materials as requested. And we look forward to partnering with the Tribes on the planned production of "The Rememberer," set for April 10-26, 2020.
