As we stated in our request for funds, SPiN Café stands for Serving People in Need. We provide a day shelter for homeless people and people on the verge of homelessness as well as very low income people. At the time that this grant was given we were open Monday through Friday from 6:30 am to 5:30 pm and provided food/beverage, lunch and other food, free wi-fi, computers and a place to rest off the streets and be safe. It is invaluable to homeless and low-income people to have a place to go where they are safe from predatorial individual, where they can rest and especially they can access resources to housing, benefits and other social services.
