Good morning,

Although I do not have the letter received with your grant I would like to report on how we use the grant fund.

We provide a day shelter for homeless people and people on the verge of homelessness as well as very low income people. At the time that this grant was given we were open Monday through Friday from 6:30 am to 5:30 pm and provided food/beverage, lunch and other food, free wi-fi, computers and a place to rest off the streets and be safe. It is invaluable to homeless and low-income people to have a place to go where they are safe from predatorial individual, where they can rest and especially they can access resources to housing, benefits and other social services.

This grant was used for operating expenses. Our day center has a high staffing requirement, and while we receive quite a few donations of food and beverage, we rely on monetary donations and grants to pay our wages.

Additionally, we are on the cusp of moving to a new location where we can serve an ever increasing population of homeless folks in need.
