In August of 2022, you generously awarded a grant of **Matter** for Medications to Safe Harbor Free Clinic. I would like to take this opportunity to share with you how we used this grant to provide services for our patients.

In 2022, we served 1134 patients in our same-day and specialty clinics. We celebrated the opening of our second clinic location in Smokey Point 1 year ago this month. Patient visits at the new location have taken time to build into a steady number each week but we are now consistently seeing 4-6 patients each Thursday evening. While this may not seem that large of a number, it is showing us that we are now reaching an expanded population of people who need access to free healthcare, many of whom are new patients to us and are immigrants to our country. As word spreads through their communities, we expect this number to increase.
