Summary:

For the Q4 2024 award of funding in the amount of [REDACTED] the following was accomplished in 2025:

Funding through the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Fund has been applied to offset project construction costs associated with the inclusion of two multipurpose classrooms on the second floor of the 12,000 square-foot Center facility. These spaces will serve as year-round instruction sites for language studies, arts and crafts, computer science, and community meetings.

These classrooms will also provide critical meeting spaces for a variety of groups, ranging from those seeking support for drug-rehabilitation peer-support groups, to family celebrations, Elder meetings, potlatches, and gatherings for tribe members.
