On behalf of the Seattle Children's Chorus, thank you for your support to our need-based Scholarship Fund for our choristers. We are pleased to let you know that your grant of [REDACTED] will provide partial tuition scholarships for six talented, deserving students who live in Marysville and Everett, and sing in our Marysville neighborhood branch during our 2018-2019 season.

Because of continued support from Tulalip Charitable Contributions for the past three years, our need-based Scholarship Fund has grown significantly so we can utilize scholarships to recruit and retain talented choristers with financial need. Thank you so much! We also leveraged this grant award in our grant proposals to the Washington State Arts Commission and 4Culture.

Seattle Children's Chorus serves 150 students in our programs, between the ages of 3 and 18. We also have approximately 4,500 people in audience attendance annually. Our choristers come from the greater Seattle area and Snohomish County.

Our Scholarship Fund is an important component of our mission to nurture excellence in young musicians. The average cost of tuition is \$800 annually. In addition, as an enrichment to our weekly program, we offer travel opportunities which require additional costs and funding. We are committed to keeping our tuition and travel costs affordable for families, but our Scholarship Fund truly makes a difference for many families.

We will continue to expand the scholarship program each year. Our desire is to give even more scholarship opportunities to Marysville and Snohomish County families in the future to have access to high-quality choral music instruction that is not available at the public school level.

We sincerely thank you for partnering with us to open the door to choral education for more young people in the Puget Sound region. It is an honor to have the Tulalip Tribes support!
