- **Empowers individuals experiencing homelessness** or housing insecurity to connect with their creativity
- **Develops deeper roots in the community** through service, advocacy and collaboration
- **Sparks joy and inspires hope** in individuals and communities that face disproportionate amounts of hardship
- **Raises awareness** of the homelessness crisis in King County

## THE PRISM PROJECT

The Seattle Symphony's 2017–2018 Simple Gifts initiative focuses on youth experiencing homelessness, which impacts nearly **1,500 youth and young adults** in King County on any given night.

"40% of homeless youth identify as LGBTQIA nationally and of these youth, 68% cite family rejection as a major factor contributing to their homelessness." – Raikes Foundation

Composer in Residence Alexandra Gardner led ten weekly workshops with youth from New Horizons, Accelerator YMCA and YouthCare to collaboratively compose a new work titled ***Stay Elevated***

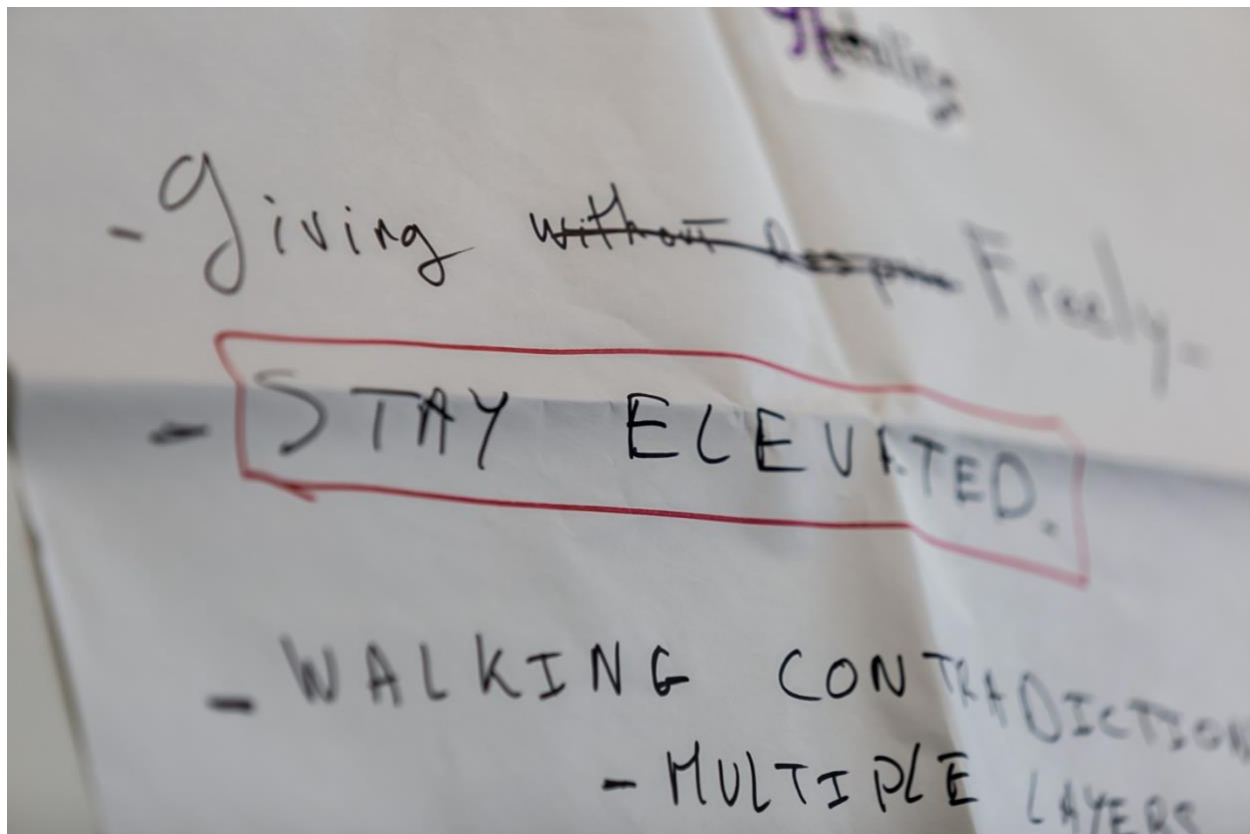
12 young persons participated in the workshops.
