Island Senior Resources (DBA ISR) is profoundly grateful to the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions for support in 2019. ISR is experiencing unprecedented growth in delivery of services to seniors, adults living with disabilities and those that care about them in Island County. The following table provides a quick overview of service growth during the first three quarters of 2019 versus the first three quarters of 2018.

PROGRAM	DESCRIPTION	COMMUNITY DEMAND
Aging and Disability Resources	Aging and Disability Resources (ADR) Specialists provide an array of resource information and assistance to seniors, adults with disabilities and those that care about them and for them. The information is wide ranging including assistance with applications for support, family caregiver information, long term care planning, Social Security, Medicare, housing, Adult Protective Services, and much more.	30% increase in contacts with community members
Family Caregiver's Support	Family Caregivers' Support Program provides in-depth support and resources to family caregivers managing care of their loved one at home.	30% increase in family caregivers receiving services
Meals on Wheels	Each week ISR delivers hot meals for lunch on Monday, Wednesday and Friday with the option of a frozen meals for the alternate days and the weekend. Community volunteers deliver the meals and serve as a safety check for each senior as many of them see no one during the week except the volunteer. In 2018 we delivered 9,025 meals, in just six months in 2019 we have delivered over 12,364 meals.	32% increase in recipients of Meals on Wheels
Medical Transportation	ISR provides transportation to medical appointments within Island County and from Bellingham to Seattle. Community volunteers provide the transportation for seniors that no longer drive and depend on these one of a kind services to maintain their health care.	59% increase in number of medical transportation trips driven
Adult Day Services	Time Together Adult Day Services (ADS) operates respite and socialization programs for seniors and adults living with disabilities in Oak Harbor and South Whidbey. The programs provide essential respite for caregivers while providing meaningful social interaction for those that might otherwise have no meaningful social contact with other adults or seniors. The ISR ADS Program serves seniors with cognitive impairment, adults living with disabilities and isolated seniors living alone.	17% increase in participants in ADS

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State Health Insurance Benefits Advisors Program (SHIBA)	Volunteers trained by the Washington State Office of the Insurance Commissioner meet with individuals by phone or in person to assist them in enrolling in Medicare and learning about drug coverage and supplemental insurance options.	50% in contacts with community members seeking advice about Medicare, Drug Coverage or Supplemental Insurance
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Island Senior Resources has touched the lives of over 12,000 individuals over the past year.

The Board of Island Senior Resources approved a three-year strategic plan for 2019-2021 in April of 2019. The Plan identifies four community outcomes and two organizational outcomes as outlined below.

Community Outcomes

1. Island Senior Resources is the recognized leader on behalf of seniors, adults with disabilities and those who care for them in Island County.
2. Community members have increased awareness of Island Senior Resources' programs and improved access to resources.
3. Active community public/private partnerships are established.
4. People of all ages are engaged in their community to reduce isolation.

Organizational Outcomes

1. Funding opportunities are optimized.
2. Island Senior Resources is a high performing organization on all levels.
