This year, Skagit Gleaners was able to serve 350 families throughout Skagit, Snohomish, Island, and Whatcom County. Roughly 10,000 individuals are served each month. Individuals of our organization increased their financial security net by cutting down on grocery costs through rescuing and reusing food from local grocery stores and restaurants. In 2018, Skagit Gleaners was able to rescue and redistribute 851,000 pounds of food and clothing to our members, preventing these items from overflowing landfills.

The freezer purchased from the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions Grant was used to store rescued frozen products from local grocery stores and restaurants. In turn, Skagit Gleaners was able to provide more frozen protein/foods to all of our families.
