GENERAL GOALS: Conserving wildlife habitat, agricultural and forest lands, scenic open space, wetlands, and shorelines for the benefit of our community and as a legacy for future generations.

SPECIFIC USE FOR THIS AWARD:

All Tulalip Tribes funds will be directly applied to the protection of key natural resources and natural lands in the Skagit and Stillaguamish watersheds and associated marine areas with a special emphasis on wild salmon habitat. Our 2014 conservation program focusing on salmon area will: (1) Work with partners to protect land within floodplains of the Skagit, Sauk, Suiattle, Stillaguamish and Samish Rivers. We will protect an additional 3-5 miles of river this year. (2) Undertake key salmon habitat restoration projects on ten of our properties including reconnecting salmon habitat that is currently blocked (3) Educate people of all ages on the importance of protecting our rich nature heritage that includes wild salmon and their associated habitat for the benefit of all generations of people and wildlife. We will send an acknowledgment letter soon and will follow up with a report on how these funds will be spent over this next year. In the meantime, I wanted to send a few photos of our current work to conserve Skagit shoreline and wildlife habitat.
