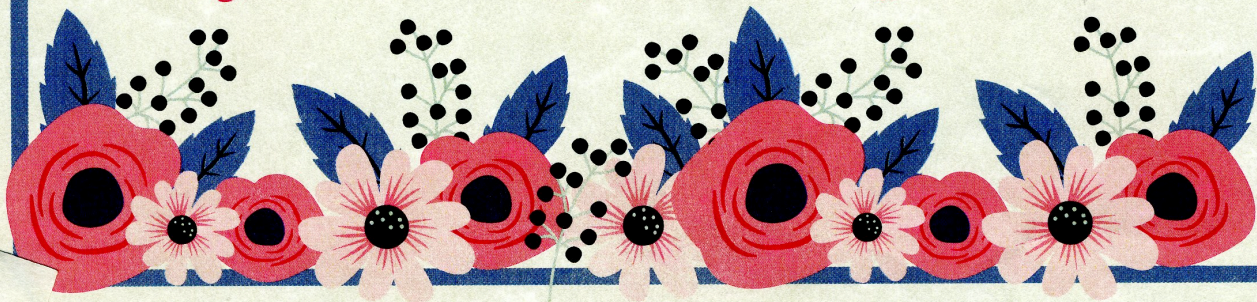

Dear Tulalip Tribes,

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continuing support of the South Kitsap School Districts Indian Education Program. The [REDACTED] grant you awarded our program in December 2017 helped to provide tutoring assistance twice a week to our elementary, middle school high and high school students during the 2017-2018 school year.

This year our Indian Education Program provided academic and cultural support to 447 students. Our after school-tutoring program began in February and continued through May 31, 2018. Your grant, combined with a grant we also received from the Port Gamble S'Klallam tribe and Federal grant funds, enabled us to provide four months of tutoring assistance in math, language arts and reading, in small groups, to 32 Native American students at South Kitsap School District ([www.skschools.org](http://www.skschools.org)). Your grant provided 67 hours of tutoring assistance to our students. Enclosed are pictures from two of our tutoring sites.

We are very proud of the accomplishments of our Native American students. We had a 68% on time graduation rate in June 2017 with 70% of the returning seniors from previous years also graduating. In addition, our Native American students outscored the non-Native population in the 2017 spring state tests in several grade levels and areas:

- 5th grade math and Science
- 7<sup>th</sup> grade reading and math
- 11<sup>th</sup> grade English/Language Arts

With limited Federal funding, we would not be able to continue to offer the same level of support to our Native American students without the tribal grant awards we have been so fortunate to receive. The additional support we are able to provide is instrumental in the success of our Native American students. Please accept this celebration of partnership gift on behalf of the South Kitsap School District, the Indian Education Program and our Native American families. We offer a heartfelt thank you for your continuing support to our students and their education.
