SEEDArts is a catalyst for preventing artist displacement in Southeast Seattle. Recently, we celebrated a major victory by purchasing the 'Hillman Hub' in partnership with Black & Tan Hall and the Multicultural Community Coalition. And in early January, we received \$1.75 million from the City of Seattle Equitable Development Initiative to fund construction at Hillman Hub. Over the next two years, we will convert the upper floor into a workspace for artists, cultural organizations and creative entrepreneurs, and renovate the first-floor spaces for two locally-owned restaurants.
