Dear Marilyn,

I wanted to thank you for your generous support of the grocery model at the Stanwood Camano Food Bank. So much has changed since March 2020 due to the pandemic and the COVID 19 virus. The Food Bank had to quickly adjust to the lockdown and pivot to a curbside pick up instead of the grocery model that was so loved by the members that come to the Food Bank. In order to be efficient, we converted the Food Bank to more of a warehouse during COVID so we could get food quickly to the families in need.

We are planning on going back to the grocery model and would like to request that we keep the funds available for the equipment we will need to reopen in the fall of 2021. We are so hopeful that we will be able to do this and keep our members and volunteers safe from the virus.

During 2020, we served hundreds of families in need in the community, our numbers tripled at one point. We provided meals to over 977 children on a weekly basis while the schools were closed. All together we gave more than a million pounds of food to families that were in need. It has been a tough year with so many lives lost to the virus, many job losses and children unable to go to school. Let us not forget the loneliness of the senior population and how hard it was on them to be away from family and friends in order to stay safe and free from COVID.

Marilyn, thank you for all your tribe has done for the Stanwood Camano Food Bank. We are so appreciative of your support and dedication to the organization. We will send an update when we are able to open back up with the grocery model.
