Thank you for awarding The NOAH Center \$ [REDACTED] to support our low-income spay/neuter program. Our clinic offers low-cost spay/neuter, vaccination and microchipping services to low-income families in our communities who are unable to afford private practice veterinary services.

The NOAH Center conducted over 8,100 surgeries in 2021, making us the second-highest volume clinic in Washington State. Over the 9-month time period, in conjunction with your generous \$ [REDACTED] grant award, January through September 2021, we were able to perform 3,396 public spay/neuter surgeries.
