“As I sat in the parking lot of the doctor’s office, fingers trembling, I opened the pamphlet for Toddler Learning Center (TLC) that was handed to me by the pediatrician during our 6 month well child visit. Within a week of that phone call, I had scheduled an in-take meeting and 2 weeks later had the appointment in my home for my son’s initial evaluation. The following week we started weekly therapy through TLC and that opened the floodgates into Early Intervention. Our son is doing very well. I do not think he would be doing as well if we would not have caught it early.”
