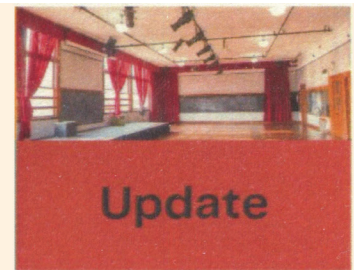

Dear Marilyn,

We would like to express our sincere gratitude for your generosity this year. With your help, we positively impacted our community and we are deeply grateful for your continued support.

Your gift has allowed us to achieve our goals and expand our programs to over 218,000 annual visits. We have provided assistance to those in need, created new educational opportunities, and promoted beneficial change in our community.

This year, with your support, we distributed 24,063 meals, hosted 37,500 showers at the Mobile Shower Station, and housed or sheltered 64% of our Safe Lot clients. Our Vehicle Resident Outreach program is growing and we were able to connect with over 800 folks in 2022.

We were able to provide 344 children with full rides or tuition assistance. UHeights is home to three preschools, one K-12 school that serves neurodiverse learners, and dozens of organizations that host after-school programs for the 3,400 students connected to UHeights and our partners. We plan to continue removing financial barriers for families so ALL children have access to quality learning.

We see your generosity manifest in supporting 12 theater organizations, providing 52 arts workshops and performances available to the community at a pay-what-you-can rate, starting with free, and amplifying the work of 20 local Seattle artists throughout our hallways.

We made significant progress towards our mission to be an inclusive space for all with the installation of an elevator, set to be completed in early 2023. Be on the lookout for an unveiling event invite, we are excited to show you what we accomplished together!

We cannot thank you enough for your support. Your donations have made an invaluable difference and we appreciate your dedication to our cause.
