Vision Church – Project RISE (Recovery, Inspired, Structured, Environments)

The RISE Project aims to provide critical supplies to individuals experiencing homelessness and struggling with substance use disorder throughout Marysville. With a growing number of individuals facing the dual challenges of homelessness and addiction, our program seeks to offer immediate, tangible support by distributing backpacks filled with essential items such as hygiene products, non-perishable food, water bottles, clothing, blankets, and local resource information. These packs are designed to provide basic needs while fostering a sense of dignity and hope, enabling individuals to take small steps toward stability.

Vision Church is grateful for the generous support provided by the Tulalip Tribes, which made it possible to serve individuals and families in need throughout the Marysville community.

Through this funding, Vision Church successfully distributed 300 essential-needs backpacks to residents experiencing hardship. Each backpack was thoughtfully prepared to provide practical daily necessities and support for vulnerable community members.

The backpacks included:

- Hygiene products
- Non-perishable food items
- Water bottles
- Clean socks
- Gloves
- Community resource guides

These items were distributed to help address immediate needs while also connecting recipients with additional local resources and support services. The outreach effort was focused on providing compassion, dignity, and encouragement to those facing difficult circumstances.
