Dear Ms. Sheldon,

Vision House continues to appreciate the recognition and financial support you have given to our organization and the vital work we do in the community. We could not serve as many families, youth and children who are experiencing homelessness without your support. I am happy to provide this report reflecting the services and programs we provided in 2025.

The challenges in our community around homelessness continue to be a lack of stable affordable housing options for low-income families; lack of rental assistance to avoid eviction; lack of shelter space to keep larger families intact; and a greater need than the system can support. Vision House has maintained a strong program of transitional housing for families with children. We have strong evidence of a program that works to equip families for long-term stability. As the number of families struggling with homelessness has increased over the past ten years, we have been adaptable to add additional services and partnerships to increase our impact.

We monitor and collect data when our clients come to Vision House and when they leave. This provides us with necessary evidence, allowing us to make changes to our program. As we coordinate a care plan for each family, program staff work with them to develop a framework of wellness that produces improved outcomes, including:

- The creation of a caring and safe environment for each member of the family
- Better self-esteem and improved relationships for children and youth
- Provision of necessary food items with families in our diversion program experiencing significant food insecurity
- Delivery of various mental health therapies to assist each individual family member as they work to overcome the traumatic experience(s) they have witnessed
- An increase in healthy communication between children and parents

One of the best ways we can share about the positive work we are doing is with a story:

After leaving an abusive marriage, Yvonne struggled to balance earning an income with caring for her toddler son, Sam, who had extreme separation anxiety. Vision House staff began working with Yvonne and Sam, giving Sam the chance to play with other kids while Yvonne met with her case manager and counselor. At first, Sam would fall apart the minute Yvonne was out of his sight, but it wasn't long before he began to feel comfortable away from his mom. Yvonne enrolled Sam in Vision House's childcare center, Children's Village. Knowing that Sam was in good hands gave Yvonne comfort

as she focused on school and counseling. Overcoming her abusive past took hard work – it was difficult to process the trauma she had experienced.

Today, Yvonne and Sam are thriving. After completing her certification program, Yvonne was able to secure a job where she could use her strengths. She and Sam moved into an apartment where Sam has come out of his shell and made new friends. Yvonne says that she is grateful for the ongoing support of the Vision House Alumni program, and for the childcare she continues to receive at Children's Village.

Vision House is extremely honored and blessed by your Foundation's support as we promote life-change for families in our community.
