2022 All State Game Unified Basketball Game

Saturday, March 19, 2022
University Place, WA

Interscholastic Unified Sports® is an inclusive sports program within a school that combines an approximately equal number of students with and without an intellectual disability on teams for training and competition.

Season Format: Throughout the 2022 Unified Basketball Season (November-February), nearly 62 Unified Basketball teams participated in 7 Leagues from across Washington. Unified Basketball Leagues are designed to mimic the structure of varsity sports, with weekly league play, District Tournaments, and a State Tournament. Unfortunately, due to COVID-19 protocols, the 2022 Unified Basketball State Competition was cancelled.

Mt. Tahoma HS Overview: Mt. Tahoma's Unified Basketball started in 2014. MTHS started the program because of the positive impact it has on the students. Their program has grown over the last several years. In 2014 MTHS only had 1 team and now they have expanded to 2 – 4 teams. They receive lots of support from the students and staff at the school. Every year the whole school cheers on their Unified Basketball team with a parade throughout the school. Unified Basketball is also a varsity sport, and all athletes and partners receive a MT varsity letter and certificate. Mt. Tahoma HS has also been recognized by the School Board for winning gold at the Special Olympics Winter Games in the Interscholastic HS Unified Basketball division.

Kamiak HS Overview: Kamiak HS started Unified Basketball the winter of 2015. Unified Basketball started because students with intellectual disabilities were not given the same opportunities to compete in athletics as their peers and Kamiak wanted to change that. KHS started to implement Unified Basketball at the recreational level and now it's a full-fledged varsity sport. Kamiak has 5 teams competing at different levels, from skill development teams to highly competitive teams. KHS and the Mukilteo School District is in full support of Unified Programming. Unified Sports are recognized as a varsity sports program and treated just like any other team. Kamiak High School Unified Basketball team was selected to represent Special Olympics Washington at the 2022 Special Olympics USA Games in Orlando, Florida in June.

2022 Special Olympics USA Games: An event held once every four years in the United States, offering athletes from across the nation to compete in summer sports, including many of the 32 Olympic-type sports Special Olympics recognizes globally. Kamiak High School was selected to represent Special Olympics Washington in the Interscholastic Unified Basketball Division. They will play against other HS Unified Basketball teams from across the United States. They will leave on June 3 and will return on June 12, 2022!
