About the True Measure Collaborative

The True Measure Collaborative (TMC) catalyzes institutional changes in schools that result in increased resources and improved educational outcomes for all students, especially students with disabilities and multilingual learners. The TMC helps schools adopt inclusive and equity-driven educational practices so that all students can thrive.

The TMC supports improved outcomes for students with disabilities and multilingual learners by providing educators with personalized coaching, program consulting, professional development and increased financial resources. The TMC is the only support provider in the state that focuses on frequent, intensive, individualized, data-driven coaching for educators.

Despite the challenges that we have all faced over the past year, and that have hit the most vulnerable particularly hard, the True Measure Collaborative (TMC) has been able to accomplish a great deal with the support of our community, funders, and school members - including Tulalip Charitable Contributions. We have coached and mentored teachers throughout the state of Washington as they've provided students with COVID-19 learning recovery services and critical mental and behavioral health supports.

Student success and growth

Over the past 12 months, the TMC has served 700 students and upwards of 225 educators in Washington state public schools, seeing academic results that show students can grow immensely when given equitable learning opportunities.

Our program is only as successful as the students we serve, and we're proud to help break down barriers to opportunity for so many across Washington.



TRUE MEASURE COLLABORATIVE

In TMC-supported schools, 91% of students with disabilities are being educated alongside their non-disabled peers for the majority of the school day (vs. 62% state average).

Ten percent more students with disabilities in our member schools are meeting grade-level standards in English Language Arts than the state average. Two times the percentage of multilingual students are meeting standards in English Language Arts and Math than the state average.

The road ahead

Over time, our goal is to serve 100 schools and 6,000 or more exceptional learners across the state by 2030.



In order to reach this goal, throughout 2022, we have readied our program for launch as an independent nonprofit 501(c)3 from the Washington State Charter Schools Association. This launch will help us expand our services and supports to hundreds more teachers and students in our state. We also expanded our staffing by three positions to support the significant growth in our programming, and built a new website for the organization: www.thetruemeasure.org, which provides a centralized hub for our work.
