Thank you again for your very generous \$ [REDACTED] sponsorship for the Refuse To Abuse® 5K on Saturday, July 11, 2020. Due to COVID-19, this year's event was changed from an in-person run/walk at T-Mobile Park, to a virtual 5K. Despite being physically apart, an incredible community of participants came together virtually to support loving and respectful relationships. The event engaged over 1,000 participants, many of whom have never been able to participate before, and raised over \$110,000 for domestic violence prevention statewide.

Your generous contribution helped us fund fees to host a socially distant packet pick-up at T-Mobile Park, shipping costs for mailing race day packets to those who could not come in person, and other logistical costs related to hosting this year's 5k event. Your dedication keeps the Refuse To Abuse® domestic violence prevention program going and more. Over the past year, WSCADV also provided training to over 2,500 victim advocates and helping professionals. In turn, these individuals provided support and shelter for more than 20,000 survivors and families. Each of our 70+ member agencies, including 12 Tribal and Urban Indian agencies, receives materials and support from us at no charge.
