Dear Director Sheldon,

Thank you for Tulalip Cares' sponsorship of WSCADV's 2022 Refuse To Abuse® 5K in partnership with the Seattle Mariners. This was our 11th annual 5K, and our first fully in-person 5K since 2019. We sold out the event at 1,500 participants and recruited 109 event volunteers. With your key support, we were able to raise over \$122,000 for domestic violence prevention for youth and adults across Washington state, engage over 1,600 participants, and reach over 5,000 people across social media. Our event website is refusetoabuse5k.org.

Our fundraising goals this year were to raise \$75,000 in sponsorships to cover the hard costs of hosting the event and to raise \$100,000 in peer-to-peer fundraising. While we fell short of our sponsorship goal with \$43,846 raised, we received more in-kind donations than prior years, with in-kind donations valued at \$13,005. We received \$100,365 in donations, surpassing our goal. This brings our total proceeds from sponsorships, donations, and registration fees to \$208,121. We had budgeted \$81,800 for total expenses and spent \$83,505, which was fairly aligned with our estimated costs. This brings our net proceeds to \$124,616. We look forward to channeling our proceeds to our domestic violence prevention work across Washington state.
