We are excited to report that construction has begun on the new Holocaust Center for Humanity. Construction is now one-third complete. The project under GLY's management is both on-time and onbudget. The HVAC system, plumbing and electrical work are complete. The steel structure and the cement pour for the mezzanine level work has just ended. Next week construction of the interior walls will begin. We will move into our new home in early January. We will be open to the public with a grand opening event scheduled in June of 2015. In the beginning, a temporary exhibit will be in place while the permanent exhibit is created; the latter will be a three-- to five-year project. During that time we will host classes and traveling exhibits, and also begin new programs.
