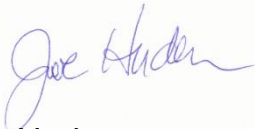
The second ad was in Whidbey Weekly also generating an uptick in ticket sales and volunteering. We also get the cover of the issue the week before the garden tour.
