Dear Ms. Sheldon,

Thank you for the generous March 2016 gift of [REDACTED] from Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions, providing general operating support for Wonderland Developmental Center. Wonderland had a very successful year of growth, in part, thanks to the generosity of Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions. In 2016, we served 494 children and 840 parents/caregivers in our early-intervention program. This was a significant increase from 2015, when we served 462 children and 792 parents/caregivers.

The greater depth of service provided to children and families through Wonderland's *The Next Level* early-intervention program has resulted in better outcomes for children and parent/caregivers and greater awareness of, and respect for, our program as evidenced by increased referrals. Funding from Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions has allowed us to provide a level of care unsurpassed in our community. This support also enabled us to participate in monthly FASD diagnostic clinics with the team at Providence Medical Center, increasing our providers' knowledge and skill in recognizing the signs and impact of this diagnosis. Wonderland has seen a dramatic increase in the number of referrals of infants and toddlers prenatally exposed to drugs and/or alcohol. Participation in these clinics has enhanced our service delivery to this very special population.

In 2016, 87% of children served in our early-intervention program demonstrated improvement and progress during the course of treatment, and 97% of parents felt better able to cope with, and support their child as a result of participation in Wonderland services. This would not have been possible without support from grantors such as Tulalip Tribe Charitable Contributions. Thank you for your belief in our work and support of our mission!
