CURRENT INITATIVES

We appreciate our long-standing relationship with the Tulalip Tribe and are committed to growing and strengthening our connection. As part of our ongoing efforts to increase collaborations with the Tulalip Tribes, the following are some of our 2020-2021 Marysville YMCA / Tulalip Community Goals:

- Health and Wellbeing and Youth and Families: Continue to communicate with Santana Sheldon, to send videos for Tulalip Tribes for Cardio Fit AOA/Senior, Strength for AOA/Seniors, Family and Adult classes over the summer of 2020. This did not have the participation we looked for, but we will continue to try other options as we move through COVID-19. Also, working with Ashley Schmidt, Community Health Nurse, collaborating on family activities for Tulalip Tribes members. Finally, trying to collaborate with Kali Isabelle Yvonne Joseph, Project Coordinator for Tulalip Overdoes Detection Mapping and Application Program (ODMAP) and explore ways our YMCA can partner.
- **Membership**: 2020-2021 the Marysville YMCA has over 100 families from Tulalip Tribes that have Memberships that are currently being used.
- **Aquatics**: Collaboration with Quil Ceda Elementary to increase Water Safety Skills lessons/trainings for Tulalip Tribes students during summer 2021.
- Elementary, Middle School and High School Youth: Partner with Tulalip Tribes Youth Services to improve graduation within the next 3 years. Spoke to over 25 students at Quil Ceda Elementary in February of 2021. I talked about the importance of education and not to let anyone steal your dreams. We also want provide more afterschool enrichment programs to students at Quil Ceda Elementary, middle schools and Heritage High School in Fall of 2021. Marlin Fryberg will be coaching Tulalip youth Flag Football at the Marysville YMCA team in February and March 2021. Tulalip youth will be participating in Flag Football, soccer and other Youth Sports in 2021. The Marysville YMCA is exploring bringing the Girls of Promise program to the Tulalip Tribes in the Summer of 2021. This program empowers middle school and high school girls through character and leadership development.
- Community: Marysville and Tulalip March against racism happen in June of 2020. Chairwoman Teri Gobin, Tulalip Police Chief Sutter, Tulalip Fire, Mayor Nehring, Marysville Police Chief, Marysville Chief McFalls, Families, Children in Tulalip and Marysville marched in memory of the murder of George Floyd. Tulalip Tribes ended the march with a closing prayer. It was an honor to be a part of this effort against racism. More work is being done with the Marysville school district to respond to death threats to students of color in the last 3 months. Tulalip and Marysville leaders and youth will be a part of efforts to be anti-racist.
